Moy Bridge (West)	Gairlochy (by picnic area)
Laggan Locks (South shore)	Aberchalder (South)
Kytra (South)	Seaport Marina (Inside fence)

Please respect the Canal's status as a Scheduled Ancient Monument by leaving your pitches litter-free and by not setting campfires. The Canal is also a workplace; please ensure your tents don't block access to locks, bridges, toilets or other buildings and paths - if in doubt, please check with our staff.

Keys to the Canal's toilet blocks may be purchased in advance by phoning 01463 725500. These toilets can be very busy - please leave them clean and tidy and don't use them for drying equipment, cooking or sleeping!!
